Dr. Bougioukli is committed to translational and clinical research that investigates innovative treatment strategies for bone repair and peripheral nerve reconstruction.

Professor Peter Giannoudis MD, PhD, FACS, FRCS, MBE, is the chair of the Academic Department of Trauma & Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Leeds, UK. His clinical practice is focused on the management of patients with multiple trauma, pelvis and acetabulum reconstruction, upper and lower limb reconstruction, periarticular fractures, post fracture fixation complications amongst and management of bone defects and avascular bone necrosis amongst, others.

Professor Giannoudis has served several positions of responsibility including, President of British Trauma Society, President of European Society of Pelvis and Acetabulum, President ESTROT Society, Chair International Membership Committee OTA, Chairman AO Masters Course, Trustee British Orthopaedic Association, Editor in Chief Injury Journal, Editor in Chief Trauma Case Reports and Chair AO Foundation Global Research Trauma Commission. For his contributions to Trauma & Orthopaedic Surgery his was in the 2024 King's Honours list receiving the award of the 'Most Excellent Order of the British Empire'.

His research portfolio includes the immuno-inflammatory response to trauma, biology of mesenchymal stem cells, fabrication of scaffolds, fracture healing, bone adhesives, genetic predisposition to fracture non-union, tissue engineering approaches to bone and soft tissue defects and clinical outcomes.

Professor Giannoudis has an H-index = 133 with 66,011 citations ([https://scholar.google.com/citations?user=xgEn\\_28AAAAJ&hl=en](https://scholar.google.com/citations?user=xgEn_28AAAAJ&hl=en)). He has delivered over 500 international keynote lectures.

He is a visiting Professor in 21 universities around the world and has published 14 textbooks and over 820 peer reviewed publications.

Dr. Leversedge is Professor and Chief of the Section of Hand, Wrist, and Elbow Surgery in the Department of Orthopedic Surgery at the University of Colorado. He is Associate Director of the Hand and Upper Extremity Surgery Fellowship and is the Co-Director of the multi-specialty Brachial Plexus and Peripheral Nerve Injury Program.

Dr. Leversedge has clinical and research interests in peripheral nerve injury and repair, tendon injury and reconstruction, and wrist reconstruction. Dr Leversedge was Director of the Hand, Upper Extremity, and Microvascular Surgery Fellowship and Vice-Chair, Education in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at Duke University from 2009-2020 and prior to his move to North Carolina, he was in private practice for 8 years in Denver with Hand Surgery Associates.

Dr. Leversedge has served two terms on the ASSH Council, including as Research Division Director, and has held several leadership positions in the AAOS, AOA, and ASSH. Dr. Leversedge was a site physician at the 2004 Athens Olympic Games (Men's Basketball) and the 2010 Vancouver Winter Olympic Games (Men's Ice Hockey).

He has a passion for international outreach and has been the team leader for the Touching Hands program in San Pedro Sula, Honduras, since 2014. Dr. Leversedge grew up in Victoria, Canada, and attended Dartmouth College (Hanover, NH) and Dartmouth Medical School, before completing his Orthopaedic Surgery residency at Emory University and his Hand, Upper Extremity, and Microvascular Surgery fellowship at Washington University in St Louis.
